Metrolinx is leading a series of major transit initiatives that will revolutionize the way people travel in and around the Greater Toronto area. As the owner of these projects and all related assets, Metrolinx is responsible for ensuring that all aspects are completed on-time, to specification, and in adherence to all legislated requirements. The Georgetown South project will increase GO Transit service between Toronto and Georgetown and accommodate a new air-rail link between Union Station and Pearson International Airport, connecting Canada's two busiest transit hubs. This \$1 billion dollar project will involve the construction of several kilometres of track, a number of major grade separations, widening of 17 bridges, and upgrading of 3 stations. Metrolinx is also overseeing the delivery of Transit City Light Rail Projects and Viva's Bus Rapid Transit projects including, light rail vehicles, storage and maintenance facilities, and ultimately the operating and maintenance agreements for the LRT and York Viva Rapidway systems.

Working with an energetic, talented and committed team as Metrolinx undertakes these transit infrastructure projects, you will supervise the provision and administration of engineering and architectural services for physical infrastructure projects, in a safe, timely, standardized and cost effective manner, as required for quality customer services. This position is responsible for supervising staff engaged in all stages of project management as necessary for implementation of major expansions as well as new, replacement or enhanced physical infrastructure projects; generating in-house cost estimates, design concept alternatives, standards, procedures, and consultant terms of reference; negotiating fees, liaising with other external agencies (e.g. MTO, other transit agencies), cost sharing agreements, approval and contractual claims; developing annual and multi-year budgets and schedules for management approval and managing fixed facility capital projects and programs accordingly. Experience in the design and construction of transit facility infrastructure, including station buildings, rail platforms, pedestrian tunnels/bridges and / or light rail and bus rapid transit would be an asset.
